Thank you to all our members who have kept our chapter going.

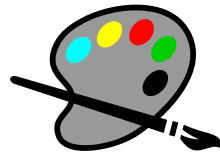

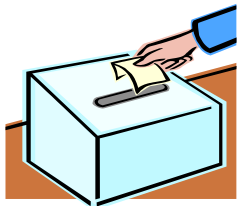

Directions to New Meeting Location

(Forsyth Academy, 5426 Shattalon Drive, Winston- Salem)

From Virginia and Mt. Airy: Driving South on Highway 52, take University Parkway Exit. Go to the right toward town. Take a right on Shattalon Drive. Continue on Shattalon for approximately 1.5 miles. The school is on the left.

From Kernersville, High Point, Lexington, Concord, Kannapolis, etc.: Driving North on Highway 52, take Germantown Road, Exit No. 114. Go to the left approximately 0.5 miles. Take a left on Oak Summit, cross over University Parkway. This will change to Shattalon Drive. Go 1.5 miles and the school will be on the left.

From Clemmons, Lewisville and Points West: Driving East on I-40, take Silas Creek Parkway to the right toward Wake Forest University. Turn left on Reynolda Road. Turn right on Shattalon Drive. The school will be on the right.

October Meeting Project Information

Multiple Christmas Ornaments (taught by Shelby Thomas)

We are going to do four or five ornaments as time allows. Complete instructions for anything we do not finish will be provided. The cost will be \$10.00. This includes ornament parts, gold paints, glitter glue, and any paint you need to use of mine and a picture with instructions. I plan to have the ornaments prepped and ready to paint on. *(Please note: there will be some gluing required for these ornaments, which will not be done in class.)*

SUPPLIES NEEDED:

Delta Paint:

- ☼ Spice Brown
- ☼ Med. Flesh
- Maroon (or a dark red of your choice)

DecoArt Paint:

- ☼ Winter Blue
- ☼ French Grey Blue
- ☼ Bleached Sand
- ☼ Bleached Sand

White

Black

- ☼ Dp. Midnight Blue

- ☼ Cool White

- ☼ Cad Orange

- ☼ Santa Red

- ☼ Dark Chocolate

- ☼ Dioxazine Purple

- ☼ Paynes Gray

- ☼ Festive Green

☼ = Only using a drop or two of these colors. Not using a lot of any color

☼ = Background colors

If you want to bring paint, but do not have these colors, bring a conversion color or something close.

Brushes:

1/8" Deerfoot stippling brush or a small scruffy brush

1/4" or 3/8" or 1/2" Flat or Angle Shader

3/4" or 1" Flat or Angle brush

#2 Round

Fine script liner (10/0 or 5/0)

Bristle fan brush or toothbrush for spattering

Bring your favorite brushes

Special Note:

We are going to be using glitter glues. If you have some scruffy brushes that you do not mind messing up, bring those. They probably will not be usable afterwards. If you have some of the small sponge stencil pouncers, they work great for this.

Other Supplies:

A large pore sponge (I will have a couple to use if needed. *Note: we may not have to do this step in class so do not worry about the sponge.*)

Small plastic containers

All other regular painting supplies

All painting in acrylics
